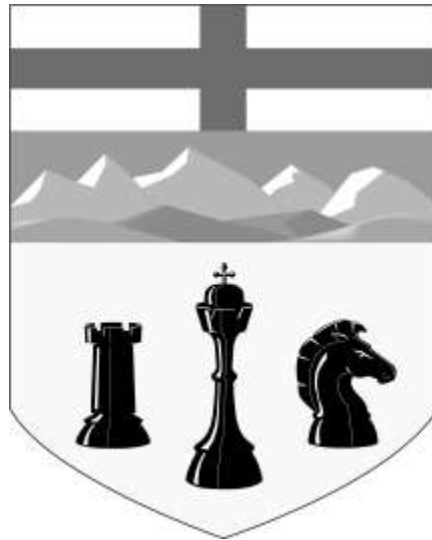


Battle of Alberta

This 1-day tournament features a 2-game match between the players, who are paired according to rating. Players will know their pairings several days ahead of time.
